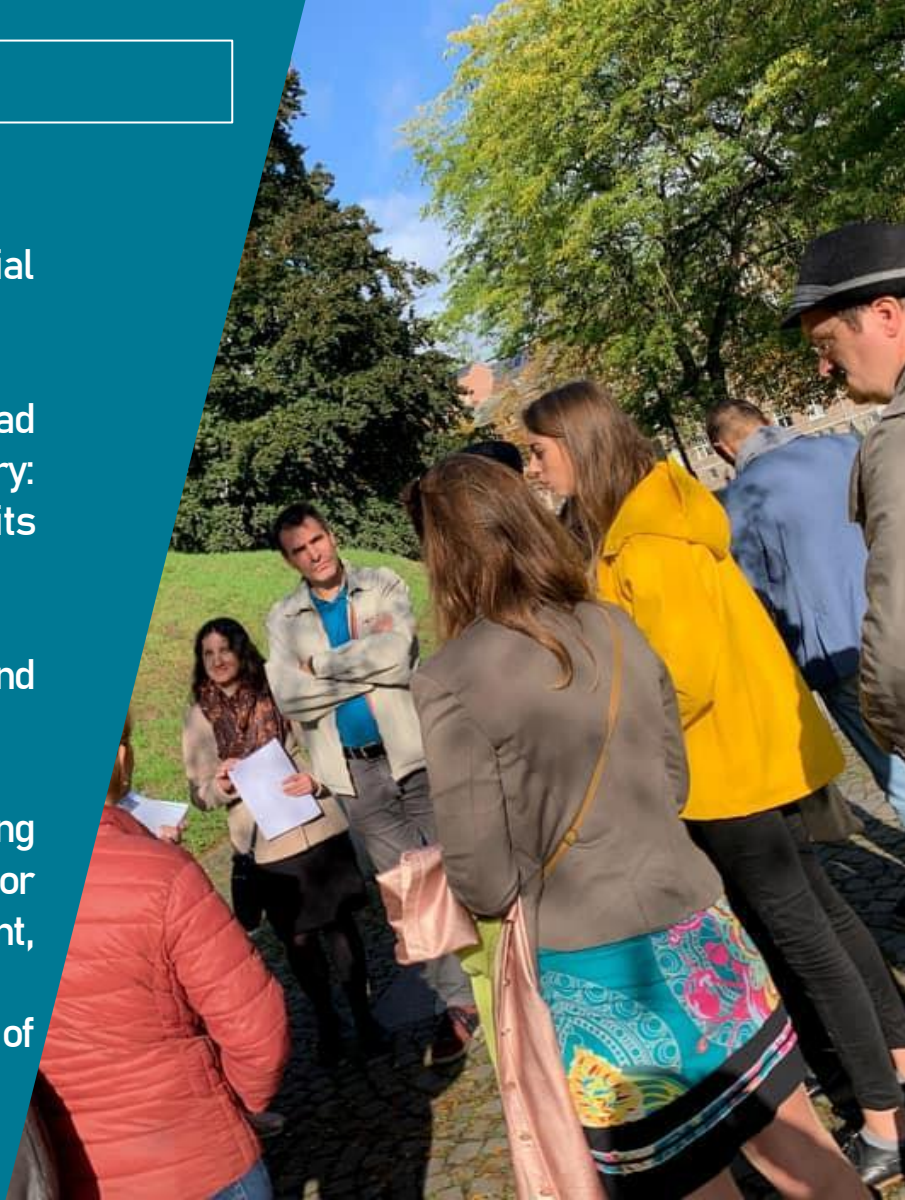
LIVE ART AS AN “ART DE VIVRE”

Art Nouveau and Art Déco in the City Center

The city centre leads us to the sumptuous Waucquez and Wolfers brothers' shops. Now respectfully the Belgian Comic Strip Centre and a toy shop, they are the only remaining shops left from the time of their construction. Horta was a fertile artist who always sought innovation and renewal. After the First World War and his trip to America, Horta gave himself over to a more stripped-down and geometric style, Art Décoratif. The most representative example of this period is the façade of the Bozar. And yes, it is a façade by Horta. Even more surprisingly, it was he who designed the well-known Central Station in our beloved Brussels.

In the 19th century, Belgium's reputation made Brussels a sumptuous meeting place. The best example of this dynamism is the birth of Art Nouveau thanks to the brilliant architect Victor Horta.

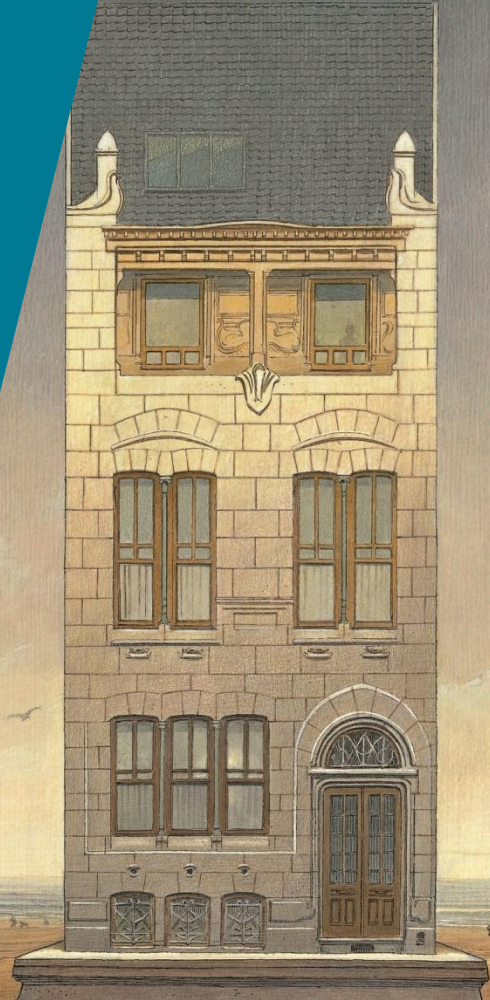
