Comics Museum MOOF:

The Moof Museum (Museum of Original Figurines), situated in the heart of Brussels, hosts one of the largest collections of comic books figurines and 3D action figures; on more than 1300 m2, enjoy the richness of the collection with one of our guides!

Belgian Comic Strip Center (CBBD) :

Located in the heart of Brussels, in a majestic Art Nouveau building designed by Victor Horta in 1906, the Belgian Comic Strip Center brings together everything to do with European comic strips, from their prestigious origins to the most recent developments.

Comic Book Rally

Brussels and comics have a long history. A history of shared pleasure, creation and international renown. This rally is a way of getting to know the temperament of the people of Brussels, through the personalities of the comic artists and scriptwriters, and the atmosphere of the stories they have brought to life. An original perspective for team building that can convey messages specific to your company. Essentially based on the theme of comics, this walking rally includes an interior visit linked to the "curves and bubbles of Brussels": from the bubbles of beer or chocolate to the curves of Art Nouveau...

Practical info

Duration: 3h-4h

The group will be divided into teams of a maximum of 20/25 pax, and will be accompanied by our guide(s) or with a roadmap to find the guide(s) in the city.

They'll receive a comic book quiz and a comic book to complete, and will take part in tasting tests.

Marolles Express : the search for Victor Sackville

Dive into the Marolles, the beating heart of the capital, with a very specific mission: help the spy Victor Sackville! - Duration of the game: 3 hours
- Division of the group into 7/8 teams
- A coordinator to explain the game, an actor who plays the role of Victor Sackville, eight cultural stations animated by our guides/actors/animators who play the role of foreign secret agents.

- Starting material: a roadmap, a timing to be respected, enigma cards to be solved to advance in the adventure.
- The animators will challenge participants to obtain a clue and reach the next stage.
- Examples of challenges: sound recognition test, marbles, the Place Poelaert elevator speed test, deciphering a sentence in Brusseleir, finding the 3 traces of Brueghel in the neighborhood, photo animation, exploring the Chapelle church in search of a bird, buying the most surreal object on the market square that could belong to Victor Sackville, coded letters to decipher, with the help of local residents.
- Final drink and prize-giving in a pivate space
- Victor Sackville animator, animation team (animator guides), coordinator/assistant, game material, final drink, tasting of a praline during the course, our services included in the price.
