Briefing by our host Hercule du Poireau

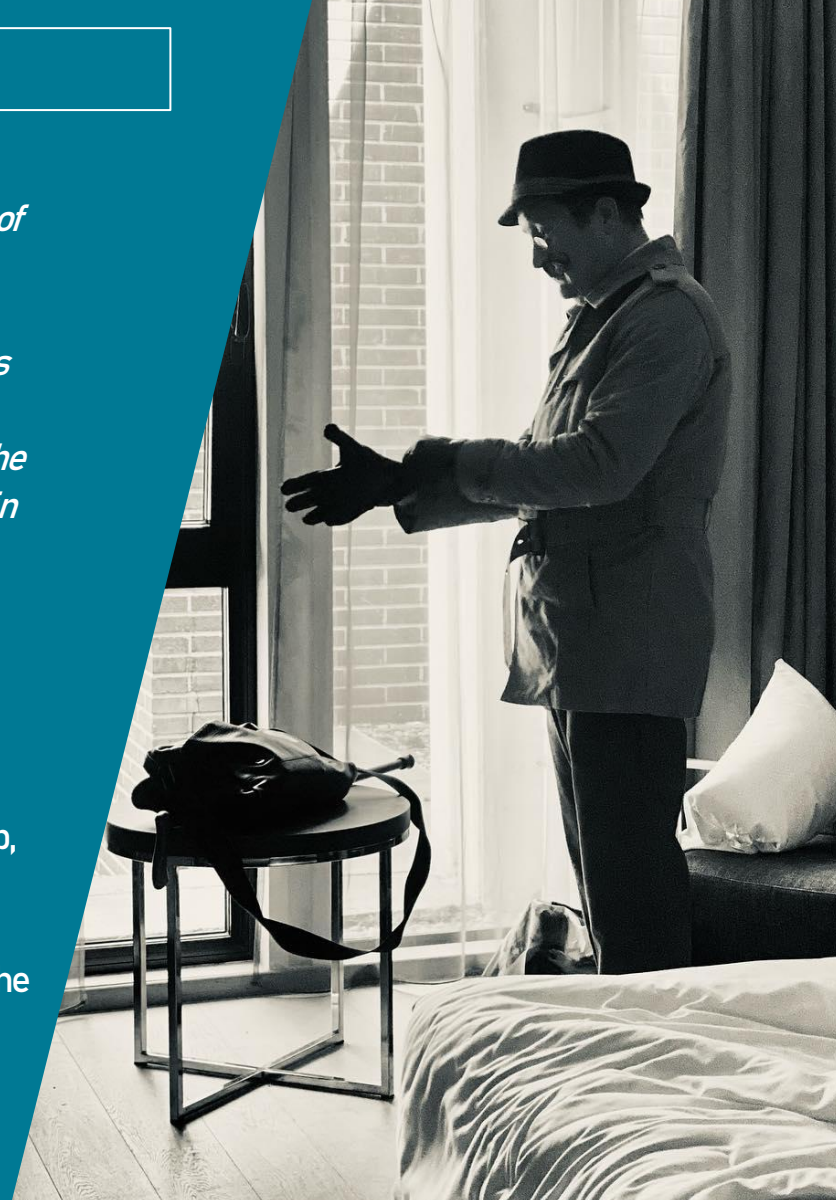
Each team receives its investigative material: suspect cards, an outlineap, a timetable
